All visitors (shooters, vendors, staff, spectators) must stop at the clubhouse and go through the safety briefing movie and get a card before going to the range. This means all match visitors, even minors. The card must be on them at all times

A Message from the Match Director Frank Strong

Let me be the first to welcome you to the 2023 IDPA World Championship fueled by Beretta. This year we return to the outstanding CMP Range in Talladega, Alabama.

Our match sponsors, including the title sponsor Beretta, have come out in full force to support this great match for all of you. Please take time to visit their booths and bays to show your appreciation for their support.

This year's match will include all IDPA divisions under the new 2023 rulebook. As with the rule changes in 2022, 2023 brings big changes. The ESP-based divisions can have compensators or ported barrels, hopefully improving everyone's time and points down. Finally, a reduction in the number of stages required for Tier 2 matches so you can earn more points for Nationals. We will have 13 full stages this year with a warmup stage to begin the match and a cool down stage to end your match. Hopefully, you improve your time on the cool down stage and yes, they count for your score.

We will face a few challenges this year with the late 9 am start, full squads, and a 6:10 pm sunset. We will need everyone's help this year so we are not shooting in the dark. On our end we have designed the stages to minimize reset and delays. This included eliminating challenging starting positions, balancing the stages in the bays, and a reduction in the total number of stages. Additionally, I am happy to state that NO ONE will miss their steel shots this year because there is no steel. On your end, we ask for your help taping and resetting. Of course, if you are on deck or just finished and are reloading, you will not be expected to tape and reset. Thank you in advance for all your help resetting and keeping the match running smoothly. With your help, we will all be successful.

As a reminder, everyone competing or visiting our match, including staff, must comply with the CMP range rules that states anyone who leaves the confines of the clubhouse and clubhouse parking lot must watch the safety video and sign liability waivers. Each day before the first stage, your SO's will check all competitors to make sure they have a valid safety card. Anyone who does not have a safety card will be asked to immediately go to the clubhouse to resolve. If you do not have a valid safety card you will be asked to leave the range.

I look forward to seeing you all in Alabama and hope everyone enjoys the match. When posting videos or photos, it would be awesome if you could tag them with the hashtag **#IDPAWorlds23**.

The CMP Marksmanship Park is a cold range. Guns may only be loaded on the firing line, under SO supervision. Off the line, your gun must be unloaded at all times. It must be holstered or cased unless you are in a Safety Area. You may case, uncase, and holster your gun only in the Safety Areas, NOT ON THE LINE. Maintain a safe muzzle direction at all times!



MATCH BRIEF

The information contained in this match book is as important as the current IDPA rulebook. Competitors are expected to read and understand the contents of this match book. If you have any questions, please contact the match director.

Rules: The rules followed in this match are the IDPA Rules as found in the IDPA Official Rule Book, effective Feb. 22, 2023.

Muzzle Safe Point: Muzzle safe points will be indicated.

Alcohol and Drugs are prohibited on the range.

Target Pasting and Safety Officer Assistance: It is EVERY competitor's responsibility to assist the safety officers in any way to reset stages. Shooters can paste at least as many holes as they punch in the targets. Please, everyone help the SOs out.

Holster and Magazine Pouch Belt Locations: It will be the competitor's responsibility to assure that their holster and magazine pouches are worn in an appropriate location per IDPA rules for their division. If a safety officer has to asked you to move your equipment to comply with IDPA rules before shooting their stage, they will note it. If you have more than one reminder, you will be assessed a 3 second procedural penalty for each additional time.

Safety Areas: All Safety Areas are marked by Safety Area signs. You may case, uncase, and holster your pistol only in the Safety Areas. NOT ON THE LINE. No ammunition may be in any Safety Area. PCC may uncase adjacent to the side berm with the muzzle point into the berm with a chamber safety flag before each stage.

Loading to Division Capacity: Unless the course of fire requires otherwise, all divisions will load to division capacity prior to each string of fire.

Nametags: Keep your nametag with you so you can eat lunch and attend the Awards Banquet Dinner.

Course Walk Through: No individual stage walk throughs will be permitted. Each squad will be given a complete verbal description of the course of fire by the safety officers. However it will be the competitors responsibility to read and understand the course of fire prior to their squadded shooting time.



firearm loaded and holstered.



Start Position: Standing at SP, facing down range with one foot touching the stick, firearm loaded and holstered with hose in your strong hand.





loaded with 6 rounds total and holstered.


PCC: Stock touching belt, rifle in weak hand loaded with 6 rounds total.
